THE K-12 EDUCATION TAX CREDIT

Illinois resident taxpayers who are parents or legal guardians may claim a credit for qualifying expenses for the education of their student (or students). You may be allowed 25 percent (25%) of your family's qualifying education expenses in excess of \$250. Your total credit shall not exceed \$500 in any year, regardless of the number of qualifying students.
